



## **Traveling Safely through Los Angeles International Airport**

### **Travel Safely**

To help create the safest facilities possible, Los Angeles International Airport (LAX) has created a nearly contactless experience from the curb to the gate. The airport has added plastic barriers at the TSA checkpoints, ticket counters, shops and restaurants, along with hundreds of hand sanitizer stations and new touchless water faucets in many restrooms. Crews are cleaning the facility 24 hours a day and face masks are required at all times within airport facilities. Physical distancing reminders are on floors, within jet bridges and on overhead audio announcements.

#### **Tips for Creating a Touchless Journey at LAX**

- Check in online with your airline before you leave for the airport. This prevents the need to interact with a check-in kiosk. People traveling without checked luggage can skip the ticket counters entirely this way.
- Order food and beverages online using [LAXOrderNow.com](https://www.laxordernow.com). This service offers touchless order, payment and pickup in any of the LAX terminals.
- Forget something? Vending machines offering a wide assortment of personal protective equipment, including gloves and masks, are available in most terminals.
- Eligible international travelers should consider using the free Mobile Passport app to speed through the customs process on arrival at LAX. Travelers are also encouraged to enroll in the Transportation Security Administration's Pre✓® or other trusted-traveler programs, such as U.S. Customs & Border Protection's Global Entry, which reduce wait times and touchpoints.

## **Travel Restrictions and Quarantine Guidelines**

The City of Los Angeles requires travelers arriving into LAX from outside California to fill out an online Traveler Form found at <https://travel.lacity.org/>, acknowledging they have read, understand and will abide by the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health's Travel Requirement and understand the State of California's Travel Advisory. Travelers over the age of 16 must submit this form online prior to or upon arrival at LAX, Van Nuys Airport, or Union Station.

## **COVID-19 Tests at LAX**

LAX now offers guests the ability to get COVID-19 tests right in the terminal area at three testing locations, the primary lab across from Terminal 6 and two satellite locations in Terminal 2 and the other in the Tom Bradley International Terminal. The tests are processed in a state-of-the-art, on-site laboratory, providing a convenient and safe option for testing before or after travel.

Standard PCR tests (nasal-swab Polymerase Chain Reaction) which are required by some destination to enter or avoid quarantining cost \$125 and are available at the lab across the street from Terminal 6 (results available within 3-5 hours). Each satellite testing site at Terminal 2 and Tom Bradley International Terminal (results available within 24 hours). Rapid PCR test with results in one-hour or less are also available for \$350 at this same location. Antigen tests are also available at a cost of \$80 at the testing site inside Terminal 6 (results available within 1 hour or less).
